How We Collect and Use Your Data

By Personal Data or data, we mean any information capable of identifying you as an individual, such as your name, e-mail address, or that can be connected to you indirectly, such as your language or location.

We collect data directly from you or our partners. When you visit our Website, we collect technical data and information about how you use the Website. We do it using cookies set by us or provided by our partners. We need this data to provide you with the Website, analyze its usage, remember your settings, and personalize content and ads.

Data We Collect

Our legitimate interests are:

- to develop, improve and deliver our Website;

- to make the use of our Website secure for the Users;
- to prevent fraud and other illegal use of our Website.

We may combine all the information we collect from or receive about you for the outlined purposes. We may aggregate or de-identify your information and may use or share aggregated or de-identified information for any purpose. Such information is not subject to this Privacy Policy.

Data Retention

We store your Personal Data as necessary for providing you the Website, compliance with our legal obligations, fulfillment of our legitimate interests, or during the validity of your consent as stated in this Privacy Policy. As soon as information stops serving these purposes, we delete it.

We will keep some Personal Data that we are allowed or required to maintain in such cases as:

- If there is an unresolved issue, claim and/or dispute we will retain the necessary Personal Data until the said issue is resolved;
- Where required to comply with legal, tax, audit, and accounting obligations and/or any other legal obligation, we will retain the essential Personal Data for the period required by the applicable law:
- Where essential to fulfill our legitimate interests such as fraud prevention and/or maintenance of our Users' security.

Your Rights

Right to access your Personal Data - You may request a copy of your Personal Data and/or how we store your Personal Data.

Right to rectification - you may request to change some of your Personal Data and/or correct your Personal Data if this is inaccurate.

Right to erasure - you may request to delete all or some of your Personal Data. For example, if:

- they are no longer needed for any processing purposes;
- consent has been used as a legal basis for their processing;
- there is no legitimate interest in the further processing of Personal Data.

<u>Right to object</u> - you may object to the processing of your Personal Data on grounds relating to your particular situation and/or to object processing your Personal Data for direct marketing purposes.

<u>Right to object to automated processing - you may object to a decision based on automated processing.</u> This means that you may request to review your Personal Data manually if you believe that automated processing of your personal data's automated processing may not consider your unique situation.

<u>Right for data portability</u> - you may request to provide you a copy of your Personal Data in a structured, commonly used, and machine-readable format (e.g., XML, CSV). Furthermore, you have the right to request to transmit the said Personal Data directly to another controller.

<u>Right to lodge a complaint</u> - you have the right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority, particularly to the member state of the European Union of your habitual residence, place of work, or place of the alleged infringement.

California Residents Privacy Notice

We do not sell the data of users under 16 years of age, unless affirmatively authorized, as specified, to be referred to as the right to opt in. The act will prescribe requirements for receiving, processing, and satisfying these requests from consumers. Personal Data Breach

A Personal Data breach may, if not addressed in an appropriate and timely manner, result in a physical, material, or non-material risk to your rights and freedoms. Therefore, as soon as we become aware that a Personal Data breach has occurred, we will notify Personal Data Breach to the person whose Personal Data is in breach and the relevant authority such as the Attorney General or the Commissioner for Personal Data Protection without undue delay and, where feasible, not later than 72 hours after having become aware of it, unless we are able to demonstrate, following the accountability principle, that the Personal Data breach is unlikely to result in a risk to your rights and freedoms. Where such notification cannot be achieved within 72 hours, the reasons for the delay should accompany the notification without undue further delay.

Children's Privacy

We do not knowingly collect Personal Data from children or process such information, without parental consent. For the purpose of this Privacy Policy, a child means any individual who is under 13 in the United States or under 16 in the European Union (or the minimum legal age to consent to the collection and processing of Personal Data where this is different under applicable law). Preference	These Cookies let us remember your personal settings. For example, your choice of language.
Analytics/ Statistics	Analytic/ Statistic Cookies help us understand how visitors interact with the Website by collecting and reporting information anonymously. For example, they let us collect information about the traffic, most and the least frequently visited sections of the Website, etc.

Marketing	These Cookies are used for personalizing the contents and ads both on and off the Website. They are also used to assess the advertising efficiency (for example, what actions the user has made after seeing the ad, whether they have followed the link).

Analytic and marketing Cookies

We use the following analytics and marketing services ("Third-party services"):

<u>Google Analytics</u>. Google Analytics allows us to collect and analyze data, helps us improve our Website. Google Analytics sends us anonymous information about the number of visitors to our Website and the pages they visit.

<u>Google Adwords</u> is a tool for measuring advertising performance. As the user clicks on an ad served by Google, the cookie is set for conversion tracking.

Google Tag Manager does not collect personal data. It facilitates the integration and management of our tags for conversion tracking and marketing.

<u>Yandex.Metrica</u> helps us get reports and record the actions of individual users, find out what people are searching for on the Website, and collect statistics on each ad in Yandex.Direct, and keep track of conversion rates.

Information about your use of the Website may be transmitted to and stored on the servers of the Third-party services, which may be located outside the country of your residency.
